- Installing two pairs of robust basketball poles for the new court.
- Applying a secure, specialised coating on the court surface will improve student safety during activities.

These comprehensive enhancements aim to augment students' educational experiences, encourage physical activity, and cultivate community spirit within the newly relocated institution.
